Respectfully represents William H Fogarty of Whitman in the County and District aforesaid, a free white person, that he was born at Fally Brook in the County of Essex in Ireland on or about the 1st of April A. D. eighteen

hundred and fifty six, being now about thirty six years of age; that he arrived at Boston in the United States of America, on or about the twentieth day of May A. D. eighteen hundred and seventy nine

and that it then was and still is his bona fide intention to become a citizen of the United States, and to renounce all allegiance and fidelity to every Foreign Prince, Potentate, State and Sovereignty whatever, especially and in particular to Victoria, Queen of Great Britain and Ireland,

whose subject he has heretofore been: all which appears by the record of the United States Declarant of the Massachusetts March

term thereof, A. D. 1883 and he now produces to the clerk here, his report of himself. He also represents that ever since his arrival at said Boston

he has continued to reside within the jurisdiction of the United States, to wit, at Whitman

and that he has never borne any hereditary title, nor been of any of the orders of nobility; wherefore your petitioner prays that he may be admitted to become a citizen of the United States of America, according to the form of the Statutes in such case made and provided.

And he further represents that he is now 36 of age; that his occupation is Shoemaker and he now resides at Edson Place Street, No. 1 and that he intends to summon as witnesses at the final hearing hereon, Daniel Donovan who resides at Central Place Street, No. 1 and also Robert Reed who resides at Washington Street, No. 1
