Today is decoration day we are having a half holiday here. It is much different than what it was to us a year ago. We went into the city that day and had a good time. Our company is playing ball against another company this afternoon. I stayed around the billet doing my washing had some washing to do. Have not had much chance to get at it until yesterday. Am in the best of health so far have not been sick at all. So I am lucky so far in that respect. Now Lena you may be expecting more letters than what I am writing. The moving about has had something to do with it but hope I can write to you often. It must be trying on you when you have to wait so long for a letter. In your letter of May 7th I thought you would have received the letter I wrote on ship also the other ones. It only takes about three weeks for your to arrive. It is more than good of you Lena to write so often but you cannot know how much better I feel when I get your letters. It makes you feel we are not so far apart after all.

We did not stay only two days in the place you thought we were at. Hope your fulks are now and that you hear from Joon Joon, your mother must be very anous waiting en any thing of your and may him for some time be some distance from where I am stoping of knew his address of le to lucate him. It must Seem good to you folks the men getting plant. wish that to plant the might ane one for our war wer ends w nd annie must enjoy see ing Vincent getting to be

We did not stay only two days in the place you thought we were at. Hope your folks are all well now and that you will hear from Tom soon. Your mother must be very anxious waiting for some word. I have not seen anything of Tom and may not see him for some time yet. He may be some distance from where I am staying. If I knew his address I might be able to locate him. It must seem good to you folks seeing all the men getting their gardens ready to plant for you and myself perhaps next summer we might have one for ourselves if the war ever ends which I hope will be soon. Fred and Annie must enjoy seeing Vincent getting to be such

All I see around here is green fields and farmers. This would be an ideal place to spend your vacation at not nay excitement just rest.
